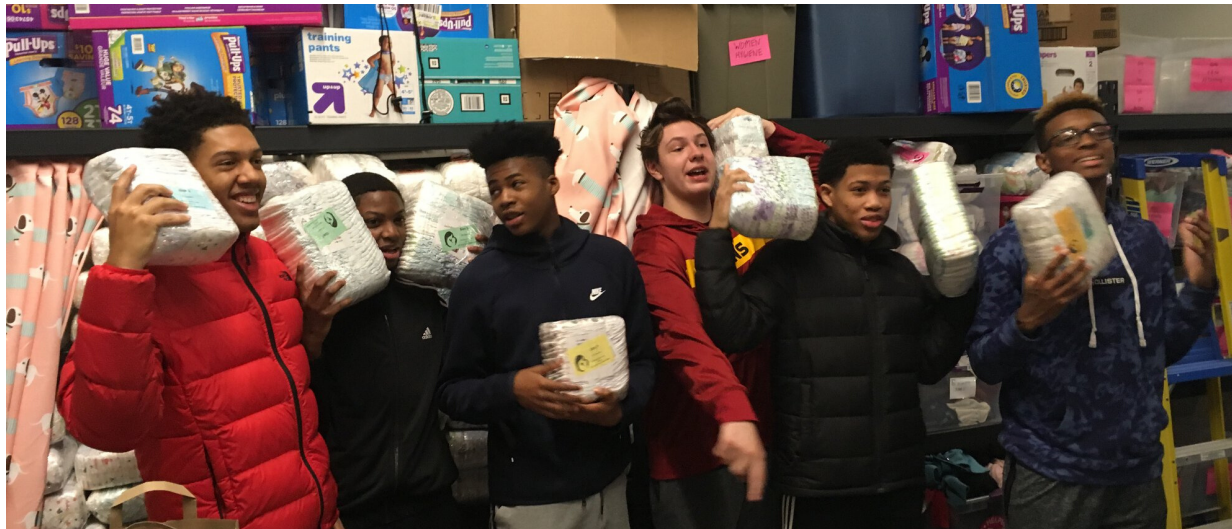

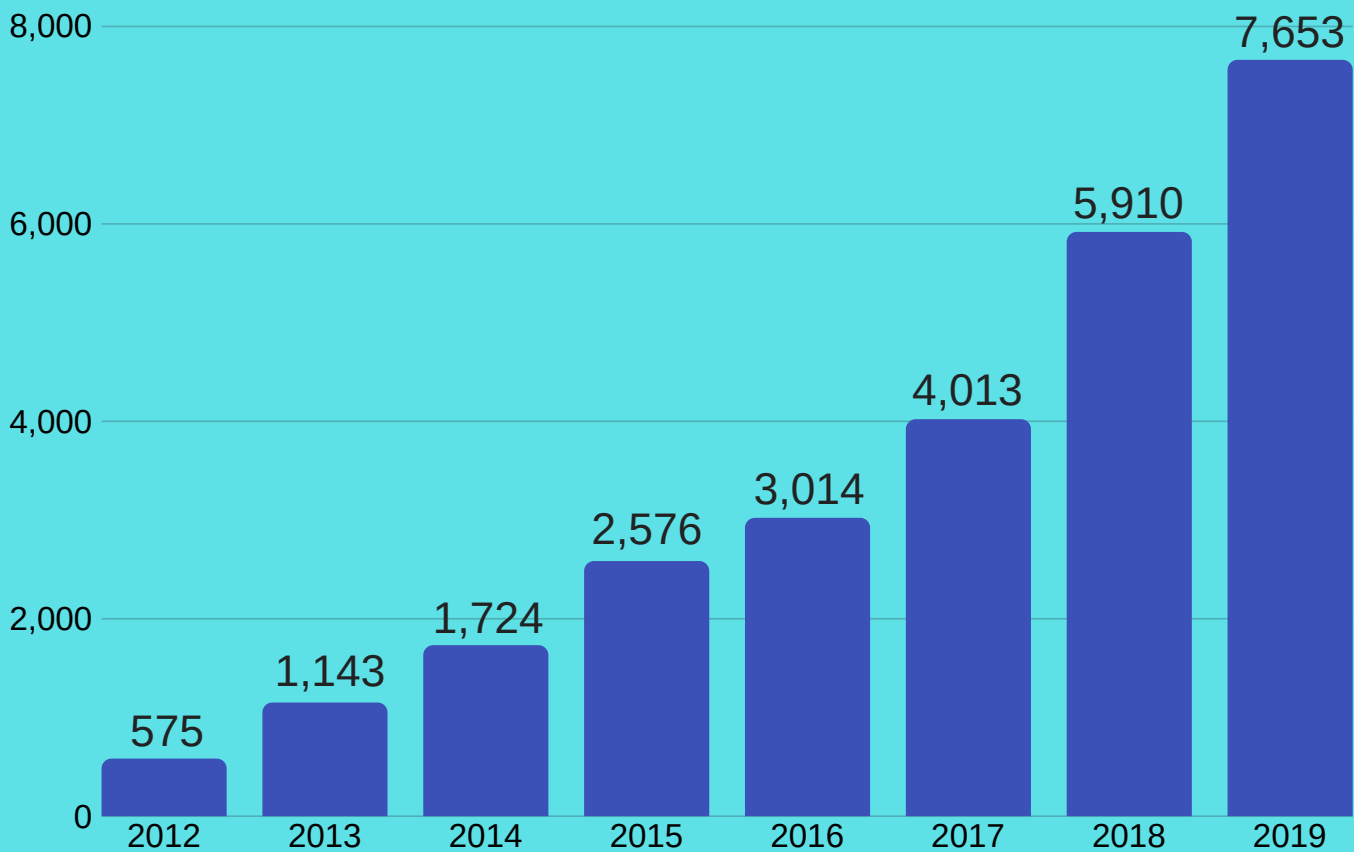

Our car repair program helped working moms get their vehicles fixed promptly, allowing them to keep their jobs and get their children to school.

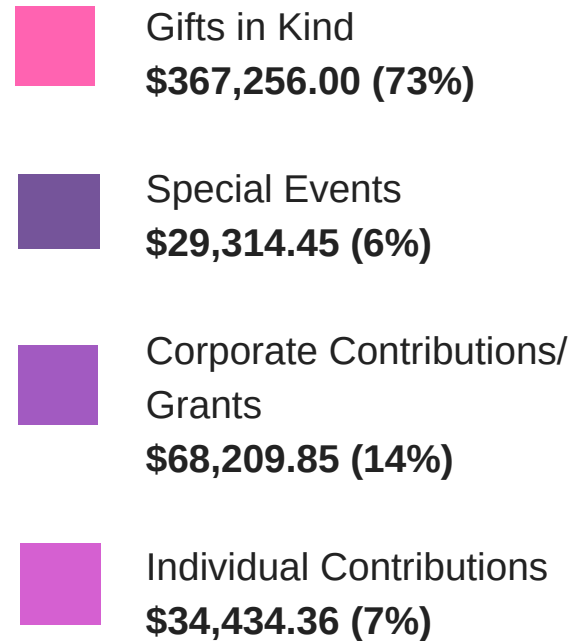
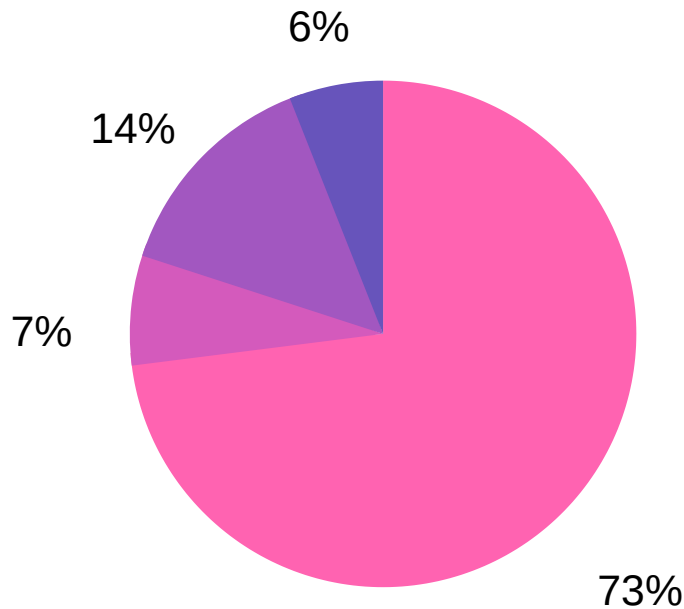
Ten families received down payment assistance that allowed them to move out of homeless shelters and into stable housing.

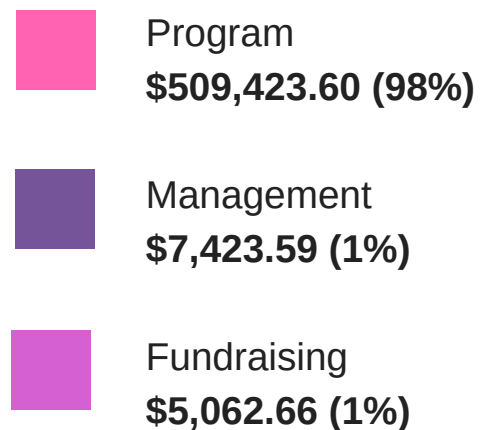
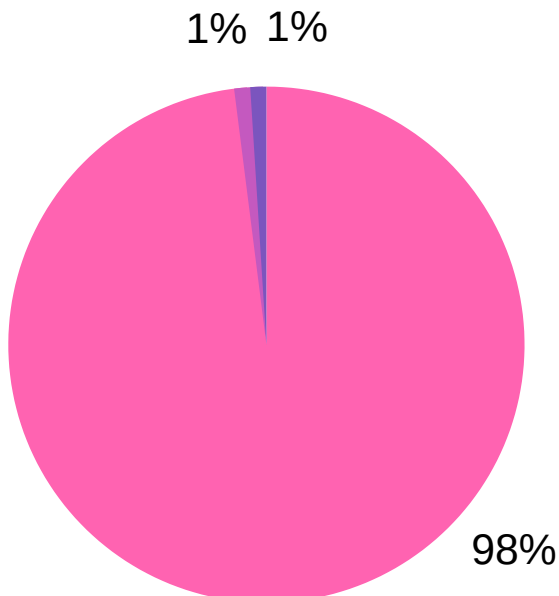
